The first donation of 10 layettes for Genesis East Medical Center, Davenport, IA, was delivered in mid-May by Chapter President, Lisa Levy. We are delighted to realize our goal of partnership with both Genesis and Unitypoint Birth Centers to help struggling parents meet the needs of their newborns.

Donors simply drove up to one of the two churches and donated newborn baby items and children's books. The visitors were given information about our organization, as well as a membership application. Most of the donations will be used in our large layettes, however, many items including larger sized diapers, infant clothing, care items, books, and toys were donated to Women's Choice Center, Bettendorf, IA.

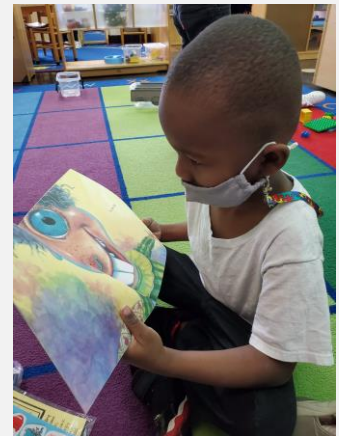
Thank You
